Arrival:

- Dancers and one guardian should arrive 30 minutes before their stage time. Please proceed directly to the check in table. Dancers will be dismissed from the stage after their last dance.
- Dancers should arrive with hair and makeup done and dressed in their first costume.

What to bring

- Dancers should bring only what is necessary with them to go onstage.
- Only one guardian per dancer, no other siblings please.
- For dancers with multiple routines, pack all costumes neatly in a clear garment or ziplock bag. Label each item with name and class on bag clearly for easy identification by teachers. Ensure all items, including shoes, are in the bag. For quick changes, layer tights accordingly. For instance, wear pink tights over beige if transitioning from ballet to jazz.

Rules:

- You may video your dancer during dress rehearsal. It is NOT permitted on recital day.
- Only DSOM South volunteers allowed backstage. Staff will help dancers change if necessary.
- Please, once your dancer has finished performing, we kindly request that you leave promptly to minimize the number of people present.
